Successful applicants will be provided financial support for their desired course that can range from SmartStart, Private Instruction (any instrument), to History, Harmony, Choir or Conducting—i.e. any curriculum currently on offer from The RCM—to further develop their creativity and overall musicianship.

CRITERIA FOR SUBMISSIONS

Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee based on their specific merit and originality of attitude towards the individual's approach to their musical studies. The committee's aim is to foster creative initiative within the RCM community, as well as to encourage and support innovative approaches to musical study for the individual Teacher or Student.
